

Map to Camp Wapiti

DIRECTIONS:

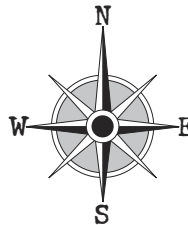
Leave Grande Prairie going south on Highway 40.

Turn left at Camp Tamarack turn-off (just before the Wapiti River valley hill).

Take an immediate right onto an access road which you will follow down the hill to the gravel pits. **WATCH FOR GRAVEL TRUCKS ON THE ROAD!** Follow the road around the bends and take the first road to your left. Go straight over the drainage ditch. On the hill to your left you will see a sign for Camp Wapiti. Follow that road up the hill and follow it past the gravel pits. Do not follow the bend in the road going South, Keep going straight West and follow the narrow road which will bend to the left. Follow this road all the way to the camp.

Follow White Roads on the Map

It then goes over a 'Drainage Ditch' and up a hill where a sign says 'Watch for the sign on the hill.' The road then turns left and follows a 'Gate' to a 'MAXIMUM 30 KM/H' speed limit sign and finally reaches Camp Wapiti. The map also shows the Wapiti River, the City of Grande Prairie Raw Water Pumping Station, and directions to Grovedale and Grande Cache. A compass rose and a legend are also present.
